Ability Programme:	In partnership with the college the CRC supports students with disabilities. The programme links Colaiste Ide and CRC in line with the National Policy, New Directions 2012. CRC provide a programme coordinator to support the students with disabilities attending programmes at level 4 and level 5. CRC provides two liaison officers to support students to find suitable work experience. CRC provides a careers guidance for students on the Ability programme as they progress through their courses. CRC provide learning support up to ten hours a week for literacy support. CRC provides exam supports in conjunction with the college

The Headway programme supports students who have sustained brain acquired injuries. The programme is supported by a programme coordinator and students participate in selected modules as part of a BTEI programme. Headway Ireland students are based in their own specially designed room.
